

0174.1 DUTIES OF BOARD ATTORNEY

The Board attorney shall, upon the request of the Board:

1. advise the Board as to the proper legal and contractual procedures in which the Board must take action or make a decision;
2. be accessible for consultation with the Superintendent or designee, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary and the Board President concerning legal matters;
3. attend public and/or private meetings of the Board when requested to do so by the Superintendent, School Business Administrator/Board Secretary or the Board President;
4. act as counsel for the Board in prosecuting or defending any action or suit to which the Board is party; and
5. perform such other special legal services as the Board may from time to time prescribe.
