

1100 DISTRICT ORGANIZATION

The following principles shall govern the administrative operation of the school district:

1. The Superintendent is accountable for all activities and personnel in the district.
2. Decision-making shall be kept as near the task as possible.
3. Under the supervision of the Superintendent, each Principal is accountable for all activities and personnel within his/her building.
4. Reporting relationships and chain of command shall be clearly delineated as indicated in Policy 1110, Organizational Chart. Whenever possible, each administrator shall be responsible to only one immediate superior for any one function.
5. Nothing provided herein is intended to inhibit the free and open flow of ideas and assistance among personnel at every level.
6. Central Staff Administration, consisting of Assistant Superintendents, Business Administrator and Human Resources Specialist, shall work with each Principal in carrying out defined functions within a school.
7. Central Staff Administrators, as assistants to the Superintendent, have extended authority in areas so delegated by the Superintendent.
