

3112 ABOLISHING POSITIONS

The Board of Education will provide the professional staff necessary for the economical and efficient implementation of the educational program of the District. The Board reserves the right to abolish positions and reduce District staff commensurately whenever reasons of economy, reorganization of the School District, reduction in the number of pupils, or other good cause so warrant. The Superintendent shall continually review the efficiency and effectiveness of the District organization and recommend to the Board the abolishment of positions and the re-allocation of duties and positions.
