

5231 NON-CUSTODIAL PARENTS

The Principal shall maintain in the pupil permanent files a record of the parents or legal guardians of every student. If one parent has been assigned custody of the pupil by court order or separation agreement and wants to limit the non-custodial parent's access to the pupil, the parent in custody must inform the Principal. A copy of this court order or agreement must be presented to the Principal before access of the non-custodial parent is denied. In the absence of such notice, the Principal will presume that both parents have custodial rights.
