

7435 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SCHOOL PREMISES

In accordance with law, the Board of Education prohibits the possession and consumption of any alcoholic beverage by any person in any school building and on school property. The possession, without legal authority, or consumption of any alcoholic beverage by any person on school premises is a disorderly persons offense.

The Board will report to law enforcement officials and prosecute as appropriate any person who violates law and this policy, except that any pupil who possesses or uses or is under the influence of alcohol on school premises or at any school sponsored activity will be treated in accordance with law and Policies 3218, 4218, and 5530.

School district employees who violate this policy or are present on school premises or at any school sponsored activity while under the influence of alcohol will be subject to discipline, which may include dismissal or certification of tenure charges, as appropriate.
