

7513 RECREATIONAL USE OF PLAYGROUNDS

The Board of Education requires that the playgrounds of the schools afford residents with recreational areas when schools are not in session. The Board reserves the right to determine, in the interest of the safety of district residents and the integrity of the school facility, the uses to which the playground may be put and the hours when it may be used.

Because of its potential for hazard, no object that is powered by fuel or battery shall be brought onto the school grounds for any purpose that is primarily recreational without the express permission of the Principal.
