## **8110 ATTENDANCE ZONES**

The Board of Education values the concept of neighborhood schools and directs the assignment of pupils to the schools, programs, and classes in a manner that is consistent with the best interests of the pupils and the best uses of the resources of this district.

The Board shall determine the school attendance zones of the district for the purpose of the assignment of pupils to school in accordance with Policy No. 5120 (Assignment of Pupils).

The Superintendent shall annually review existing attendance zones and recommend to the Board such changes as may be justified by considerations of safe pupil transportation and travel; convenience of access to the schools; financial and administrative efficiency, the effectiveness of the instructional program, and a wholesome and educationally sound balance of pupil populations.

Pupils may be permitted to attend a school outside his/her assigned attendance zone under the following circumstances:

1. The pupil has moved to a different attendance zone during the school year and the parent/guardian requests that the child be permitted to complete the school year in the current school.
2. The pupil has moved to a different attendance zone and the parent guardian requests that the child be permitted to complete his/her final year in the current school.
3. There is space available in a school outside the pupil's attendance zone and such a change would help relieve overcrowding in the pupil's zoned school.

All such requests will be reviewed and renewed on an annual basis by the Superintendent.

This is a newly adopted version of Westfield Board of Education Policy 8110 "Attendance Zones". The first reading of this newly adopted version of Policy 8110 "Attendance Zones" occurred on November 16, 2010. The formal adoption of the within version of Policy 8110 "Attendance Zones" occurred on December 14, 2010.

This newly adopted version of Policy 8110 “Attendance Zones” is intended to achieve full and complete procedural, technical and substantive compliance with the Decision of the New Jersey Commissioner of Education in the matter bearing Dkt. No. EDU 07387-09, OAL Dkt. No. EDU 01020-10, Commissioner Decision No. 459-10R. The procedures for the first reading and final approval of this newly adopted version of Policy 8110 “Attendance Zones” are fully compliant with the Board’s Policy 0131 “Bylaws and Policies”.

## **R 8110 – ATTENDANCE ZONES**

### **Elementary School Boundaries**

#### **Lincoln School**

All pupils living within the Town of Westfield boundaries that are eligible for kindergarten shall attend Lincoln School.

#### **Franklin School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Franklin School. Beginning at the northwest corner of the town of Westfield, southward along the town line to the railroad tracks; thence east along the railroad tracks to Broad Street; thence northeast along the center of East Broad Street to Mountain Avenue; thence north along the center of Mountain Avenue to the town line; thence along the town line to the starting point.

#### **Jefferson School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Jefferson School. Beginning at the railroad tracks at a point opposite the north property line of Windsor Avenue, including both sides of Windsor Avenue to Central Avenue; thence south along the Center line of Central Avenue to the south property line of Grove Street; thence southwest on Grove, excluding both sides of Grove to Summit Avenue; thence south on Summit Avenue including both sides of Summit Avenue to Clifton Street, thence southwest on Clifton Street, excluding both sides of Clifton Street to the East side of Rahway Avenue; thence south along the center line of Rahway Avenue, including the east side of Rahway Avenue to the town line, thence along the town line to the starting point.

#### **McKinley School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend McKinley School. Beginning at the railroad on Central Avenue, the line runs southeast through the center of Central Avenue, to the rear property line of Park Street; thence along the rear property line of Park Street, including both sides of Park Street to Westfield Avenue; thence through the center of Dorian Road to Rahway Avenue; thence south along the center line of Rahway Avenue to Shackamaxon Drive; thence southwest along Shackamaxon Drive, excluding both sides of Shackamaxon Drive to Lamberts Mill Road; thence north on Lamberts Mill Road and the town line to the railroad; thence along the railroad to the starting point.

**Tamaques School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Tamaques School. Beginning at the corner of Lamberts Mill Road and Shackamaxon Drive, the line runs northeast along Shackamaxon Drive, including both sides of Shackamaxon Drive to Rahway Avenue; thence north along the center line of Rahway Avenue to Dorian Road; thence northeast along the center line of Dorain Road to Westfield Avenue; thence along the rear property line of Park Street, excluding both sides of Park Street, to Central Avenue; thence northwest along the center line of Central Avenue to the railroad; thence east along the railroad to a point across from Livingston Street; thence southwest along the rear property line of Livingston Street to Central Avenue; thence along the center line of Central Avenue to Grove Street; thence southwest along Grove Street including both sides of Grove Street to Summit Avenue; thence south along the west property line of Summit Avenue, excluding both sides of Summit Avenue to Clifton Street; thence southwest on Clifton Street including both sides of Clifton Street to Rahway Avenue; thence south along the center line of Rahway Avenue including the west side of Rahway Avenue to the town line; thence along the town line to the starting point.

**Washington School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Washington School. Beginning at the intersection of East Broad Street and the railroad the line goes northeast along the center of East Broad Street to Springfield Avenue; thence northeast along the rear property line of Nomahegan Drive, including both sides of Nomahegan Drive to the town line; thence southwest along the town line to the railroad; thence west along the railroad to the starting point.

**Wilson School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Wilson School. Beginning at the northeast corner of the town of Westfield; thence southeast on Springfield Avenue to the rear property line of Nomahegan Drive, excluding both sides of Nomahegan Drive to East Broad Street; thence southwest along the center of East Broad Street to Mountain Avenue; thence north along the center of Mountain Avenue to the town line thence along the town line to the starting point.

## **INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL BOUNDARIES**

### **Edison Intermediate School**

All pupils living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Edison Intermediate School. Beginning at the town line of Scotch Plains at the railroad tracks; thence east on the railroad tracks to the town line of Garwood; thence northeast along the town line to the northeast of Fourth Avenue; thence northwest along Benson Place, excluding both sides of Benson Place, to the northside of Harding Street; thence northeast along Harding Street, including both sides of Harding Street, to the westside of Wells Street; thence northwest along Wells Street, including both sides of Wells Street, to the center of East Broad Street; thence northeast along the center of East Broad Street to Springfield Avenue; thence northeast along the rear property line of Nomahegan Drive, including both sides of Nomahegan Drive, to the Cranford town line; thence southeast to the Garwood town line; thence south along the town line to the starting point.

### **Roosevelt Intermediate School**

All students living within the area bounded by the following line shall attend Roosevelt Intermediate School. Beginning at the town line of Scotch Plains at the railroad tracks, thence east on the railroad tracks to the town line of Garwood; thence northeast along the town line to the northeast of Fourth Avenue; thence northwest along Benson Place, including both sides of Benson Place, to the northside of Harding Street; thence northeast along Harding Street, excluding both sides of Harding Street, to the eastside of Wells Street; thence northwest along Wells Street, excluding both sides of Wells Street, to the center of East Broad Street; thence northeast along the center of East Broad Street to Springfield Avenue; thence northeast along the rear property line of Nomahegan Drive, excluding both sides of Nomahegan Drive, to the Cranford town line; thence north along the town line to the starting point.
