

9230 PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITIES

The Board of Education believes children benefit when parents or legal guardians recognize and discharge a responsibility to encourage and support the learning process.

Parents or legal guardians can help children learn by:

- Requiring children obey all school rules and by accepting responsibility for a child's improper conduct;
- Sending children to school with proper attention to health, personal cleanliness, and dress;
- Maintaining an active interest in each child's daily work and making it possible for the child to complete assigned homework by providing a quiet place and suitable conditions for study;
- Reading communications from the school and signing and returning them promptly when so requested;
- Attending conferences arranged for the exchange of information on the child's progress in school; and
- Scheduling family matters to minimize interference with school time.

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
