## FINANCE

1. Approve 2019-2020 Budget

BE IT RESOLVED that the tentative budget be approved for the 2019-2020 School Year using the 2019-2020 state aid figures and the Secretary to the Board of Education be authorized to submit the following tentative budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval in accordance with the statutory deadline:

And to advertise said tentative budget in the *Westfield Leader* in accordance with the form suggested by the State Department of Education and according to law; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that a public hearing be held in the Board Room of the Administration Building, 302 Elm Street, Westfield, New Jersey on April 30, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the budget for the 2019-2020 School Year.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Westfield Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for increases for the costs of health benefits in the amount of \$733,498. The additional funds are included in the base budget and will be used to pay for the additional increases in health benefits.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Westfield Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for banked cap in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b). The district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority and must increase the base budget in the amount of \$69,289, for the purpose of purchasing additional lap top carts and instructional supplies for technology. The district intends to complete said purposes by June 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Westfield Board of Education requests the approval of a capital reserve withdrawal in the amount of \$10,304,375. The district intends to utilize these funds for the capital projects, at various schools, including classroom renovations, and field renovations.

#### 2. Approve Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement 2019-2020

WHEREAS, the Westfield Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel only, an annual school year threshold of \$150 per staff member where prior Board approval shall not be required unless this annual threshold for a staff member is exceeded in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7, to a maximum expenditure of \$500,000, for all staff and board members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Business Administrator track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

3. <u>Approve</u> the following Resolution:

## APPROVAL TO RETURN UNUSED BOND PROCEEDS TO DEBT SERVICE

WHEREAS, NJSA 18A:24-54 permits a Board of Education to transfer the proceeds of a capital project when the project is completed, and such funds are no longer necessary for the original purpose or any other authorized purpose; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned statute authorizes the Board of Education to determine whether to apply such funds to either the general fund or the debt service fund of the district; and

WHEREAS, the Westfield Board of Education has determined that \$123,734.31 is available for such transfer;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Westfield Board of Education that it hereby authorizes the district's school business administrator to make this transfer to the debt service fund consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.
